## ORDER

Of the Solicitors Disciplinary Tribunal  
Constituted under the Solicitors Act 1974

The Tribunal makes an Order pursuant to Rule 35 (9) of the Solicitors (Disciplinary Rules) 2019.

### **Anonymity Order**

The Tribunal orders that the identity of Client A who will not be giving evidence during the hearing and who is referred to in the Rule 12 Statement as “Client A”, shall not be disclosed or published.

Accordingly, the Tribunal directs that no person shall publish or disclose any matter likely to lead to the identification of Client A.
