ORDER

Of the Solicitors Disciplinary Tribunal
Constituted under the Solicitors Act 1974

The Tribunal makes an Order pursuant to Rule 35 (9) of the Solicitors (Disciplinary Rules) 2019.

Anonymity Order

The Tribunal orders that the identity of the Respondent's witness, who gave evidence during the hearing and who is referred to in the Tribunal's written judgment as "Person B", shall not be disclosed or published.

Accordingly, the Tribunal directs that no person shall publish or disclose any matter likely to lead to the identification of Person B.

For the avoidance of doubt:

1. The witness shall be referred to as "Person B" in the published judgment and any other publicly available case-related material.
2. Any recording or transcript of the hearing supplied by or on behalf of the Tribunal shall be provided subject to this order, and recipients must not publish or disclose any part of that material that would identify Person B.

This direction shall remain in force unless varied or revoked by the Tribunal.
